- #2 Set a steel pin for E 1/16 from which a 10" Larch bears S 24° 42' W 39.50 feet scribed E 1/16 S 29 and posted - a 12" Larch bears N 19° W 34.30 feet scribed E 1/16 Posted.
- #3 Set a steel pin for 1/16 W from which a 10" Cedar bears N 33° W 21.90 feet scribed W 1/16 S 21
- #4 Set a steel pin for N 1/16 E from which a 28" Hemlock bears N 25° W 9.50 feet scribed N 1/16 E and posted an 18" Hemlock bears S 54° W 18.00 feet scribed N 1/16 E and posted.
- #5 Set a steel pin for 1/16 N from which an 18" Cedar bears S 63° W 14 feet scribed N 1/16 S 29 and posted. a 10" Hemlock bears S 44° E 16.50 feet scribed N 1/16 and posted.
- #6 Set a steel pin for N 1/16 W from which a 16" pine bears N 35° W 16.30 feet - an 8" Cedar bears N 65° E 6.5 feet both scribed N 1/16 W and posted.
- #7 Set a steel pin from which an 18" Cedar bears N 55° 40' W 22.30 feet scribed C 1/16 E and posted A 30" Cedar bears S 11° E 11.30 feet scribed C 1/16 E and
