A tamarack, 9 inc. diam., bears S. 83° W., 34 lks, dist., marked T 30 N R 26 W S 1 C C B T.

Found iron pipe with brass cap.

Found a larch, 19 in. diam., bears S. 82° W., 24.4 ft. dist., for Sec. 1.

Perpetuation :

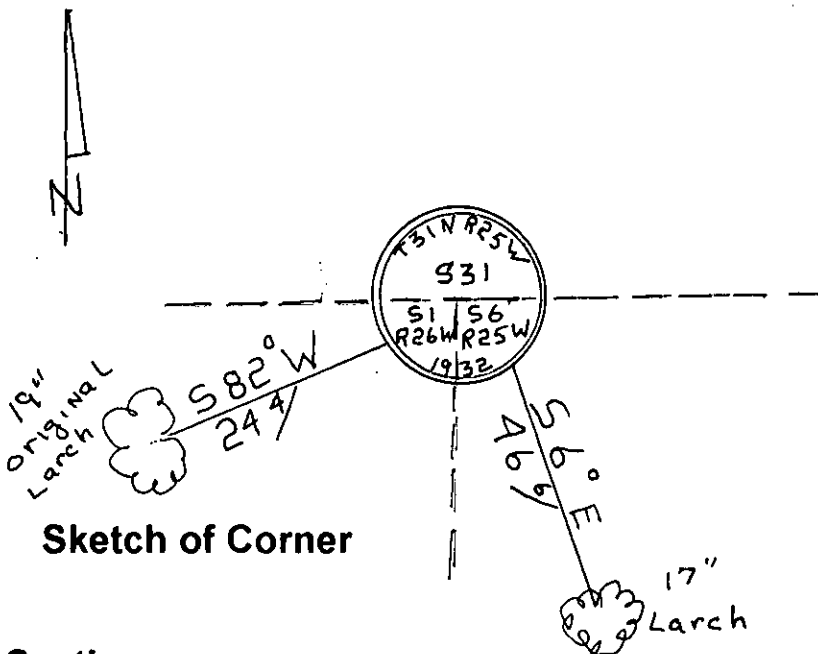
Established the following new Bearing Tree:
