Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the 1/4 sec. cor. for sec. 1 only, with brass cap.

A lodgepole pine, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 30° E., 33 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 1 B T.

A lodgepole pine, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 21° W., 30 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 1 B T.

Found Evidence :

Found iron pipe with brass cap.

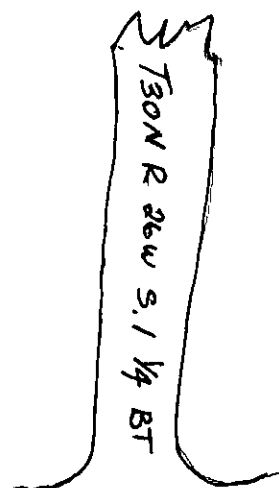
Found 8 in. original Douglas Fir Bearing Tree which bears S. 26° W., 6.6. ft. dist.

Perpetuation :

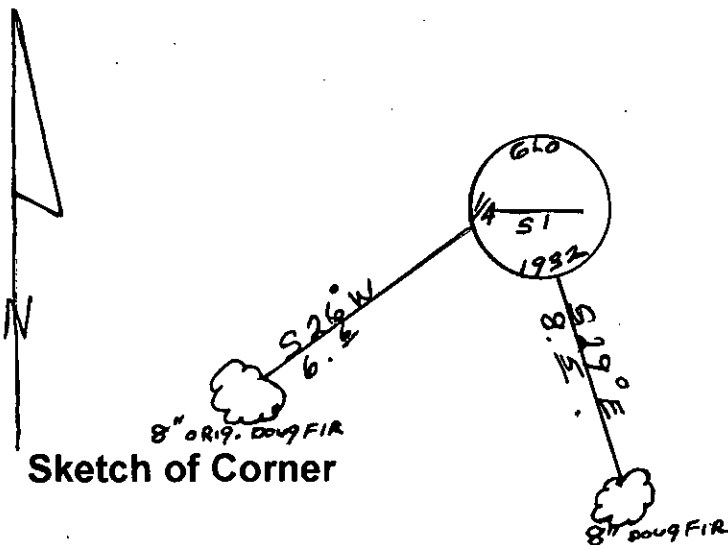
Established the following new Bearing Tree:

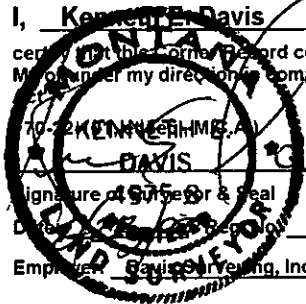

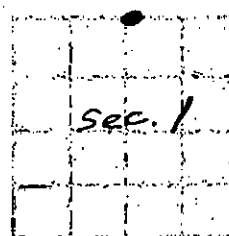
