Record: A limestone 10"x 8"x 8" above ground firmly set from which:

- A tamarack 12" dia. bears S20-1/2°E, 53 lks

Found: Iron post with brass cap 8" above ground - mound of stone alongside from which:

- A 12" tamarack stump bears S20-1/2°E, 35.0 ft
- A 14" tamarack stump bears S71-1/4°W, 17.2 ft

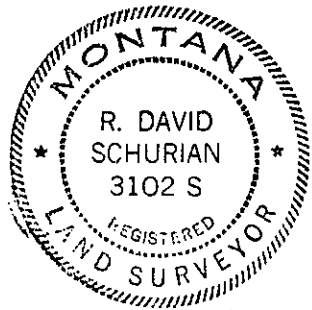

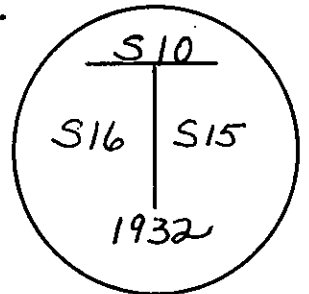
