

CERTIFIED CORNER RECORD

Corner CC Sec. Cor. 17 ^{8/9} T. 30 N., R. 26 W., P.M.M. Lincoln County

Record :

1932 GLO Survey by Lyman.

"Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the closing corner of Secs. 8 and 9 only, with brass cap, from which:

A pine, 8 ins. diam., bears N 79 1/4° E, 74 lks. dist., marked T30N R26W S9 CC BT".

A pine, 9 ins. diam., bears N 30° W, 56 lks. dist., marked T30N R26W S8 CC BT".

Found Evidence :

A 2 inch dia. iron pipe with a 2 1/2 inch dia. brass cap marked as shown below, 8 ins. exposed above ground and slightly bent from past logging activities, from which:

A Lodgepole snag fallen over with visible scribing bears N 30° W, 56 lks. dist.

Two (2) Bearing Trees, origin unknown.

A Larch 21 1/2 ins. dia. bears N 58°30' W, 72 lks. dist., with visible scribing.

A Larch 10 3/4 ins. dia. bears N 10° E, 48.40 ft. dist., with overgrown face.

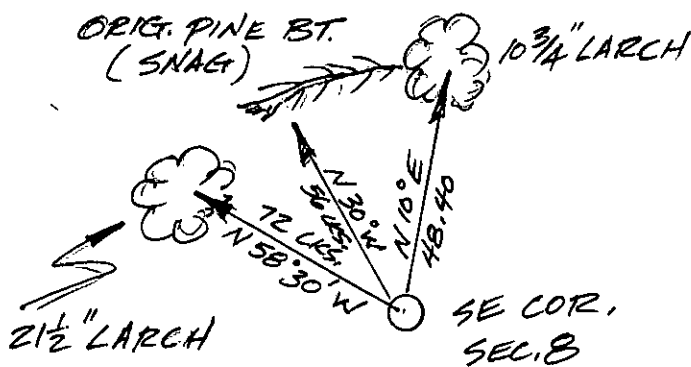
Perpetuation :

Painted scribed faces red and 6 inch wide bands around the Bearing Trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs where needed.

Set a steel guard post 2.50 ft. on line N of corner with attached Land Survey Monument and Property Line stickers.
