
## **CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION**

I. <u>1893 G.L.O. Original Record by James S. Keerl et. al.:</u> Set a granite stone, 15x12x10 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. to secs. 7,8,17&18, mkd. with 4 notches on S. and 5 notches on the E. edges. Raise a mound of stone, 1 1/2 ft. high, 2 ft. base, alongside. No bearing trees available.

1982 B.L.M. Remonumentation Record by Cruz D. Almanza: Found granite stone 15x12x10 ins., firmly set, 10 ins. in the ground, mkd. as described in the original record and witnessed by a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, alongside. At the corner point, set an aluminum pipe, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap mkd. as shown:



Established four bearing trees, bury the original stone alongside and raise a collar of stone, 3 ft. diam., around the aluminum pipe.

II. Found a 2 1/2 in. diam. aluminum pipe, protruding 3 ins. above the ground, firmly set in a collar of stone, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap mkd. as shown above.

From which:

A larch, 14 ins. diam., bears N27°E, 54.8 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. (record)


A larch, 22 ins. diam., bears S46°E, 23.8 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. (record)


A larch, 19 ins. diam., bears S60°W, 19.8 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. (record)

A larch, 16 ins. diam., bears N54°W, 45.5 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. (record)


III. Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
