
CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner Sec. Cor. Sec. 4,5,8&9 T. 30N R. 27W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. <u>1893 G.L.O. Original Record by James S. Keerl et. al.</u>: Set a sandstone, 20x10x6 ins., 15 ins. in the ground, for cor. to secs. 4,5,8&9, mkd. with 5 notches on S. and 4 notches on the E. edges. Raise a mound of stone, 1 1/2 ft. high, 2 ft. base, alongside. No bearing trees established.

1966 B.L.M. Remonumentation Record by Roy G. Leedy: Found sandstone, 20x12x4 ins., firmly set, mkd. as described in the original record. At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 in diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. diam. to top, with brass cap mkd. as shown:



Established four bearing trees, buried the original stone alongside the iron post.

1981 Certified Corner Recordation by Melvin D. Lauteren, Reg. No. 4232-S: On file at the Lincoln County Courthouse, recorded on the 29th day of May, 1981, was assigned page No. 1027, in book No. 1.

II. Found a 2 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, protruding 7 ins. above the ground, firmly set, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown above.

A larch, 13 ins. diam., bears N40°E, 21.8 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. (BLM-record)

A larch, 15 ins. diam., bears S8°E, 24.4 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. (BLM-record)


A down larch, 10 ins. diam., bears S33°W, 4.6 ft. dist., mkd. with visible scribe. (BLM-record)

A larch, 14 ins. diam., bears N64°W, 13.2 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. (BLM-record)

III. Established one new bearing tree:

A larch, 11 ins. diam., bears S6°W, 23.6 ft. dist., mkd. "T30N R27W S8 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
