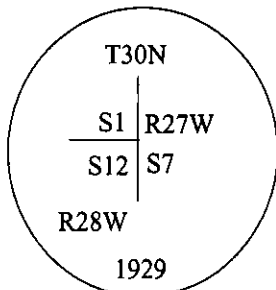


CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner Sec. Cor. Sec. 1 & 12 T. 30N R. 28W P.M., MT Lincoln County

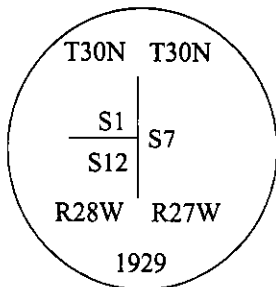
- I. 1893 G.L.O. Original Record by James S. Keerl et. al.: Set a wooden post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, for cor to secs. 1,6,7&12, mkd. "T30N S6" on N.E., "R27W S7" on S.E., "R28W S12" on S.W., and "S1" on the N.W. faces, with 1 notch on the N. and 5 notches on the S. edges". Established four bearing trees.

1929 G.L.O. Resurvey of the W. Boundary of T30N, R27W by Ray D. Armstrong: For the newly established cor. of secs. 1 & 12, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with the brass cap mkd. as shown:



Established two new bearing trees.

- II. Found a 2 in. diam. pipe, protruding 9 ins. above the ground, firmly set, with a 2 1/2 in. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown:



*Cap mkd. different than record.

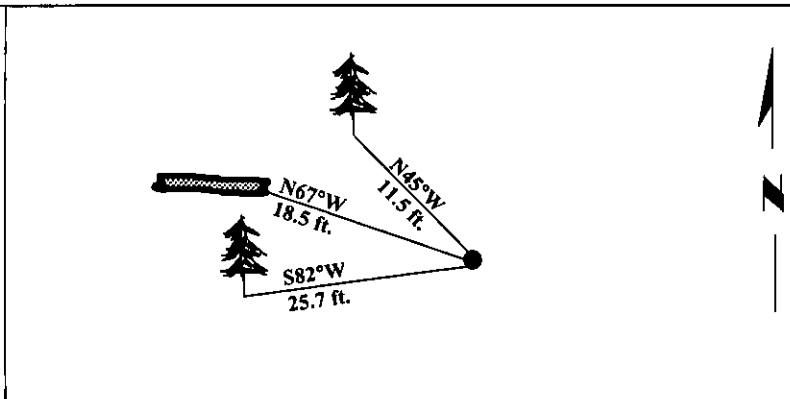
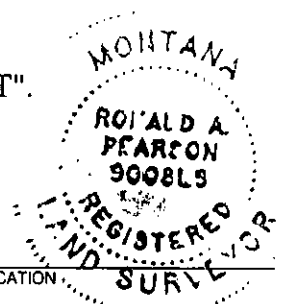
from which:

A larch, 16 ins. diam., bears S82°W, 25.7 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. (record)
A down pine, 8 ins. diam., bears N67°W, 18.5 ft. dist., mkd. with a visible scribe. (record)

- III. Established one new bearing tree:
A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears N45°W, 11.5 ft. dist., mkd., "T30N R28W S1 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.

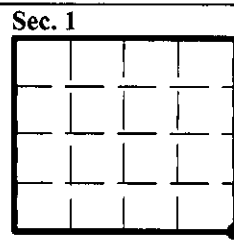
