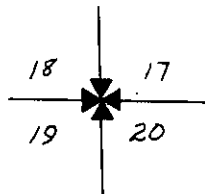

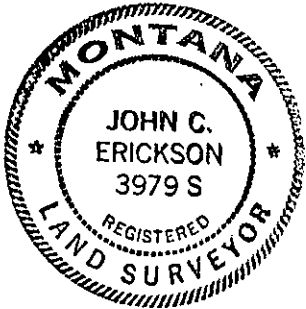

= Corner recorded on the sheet

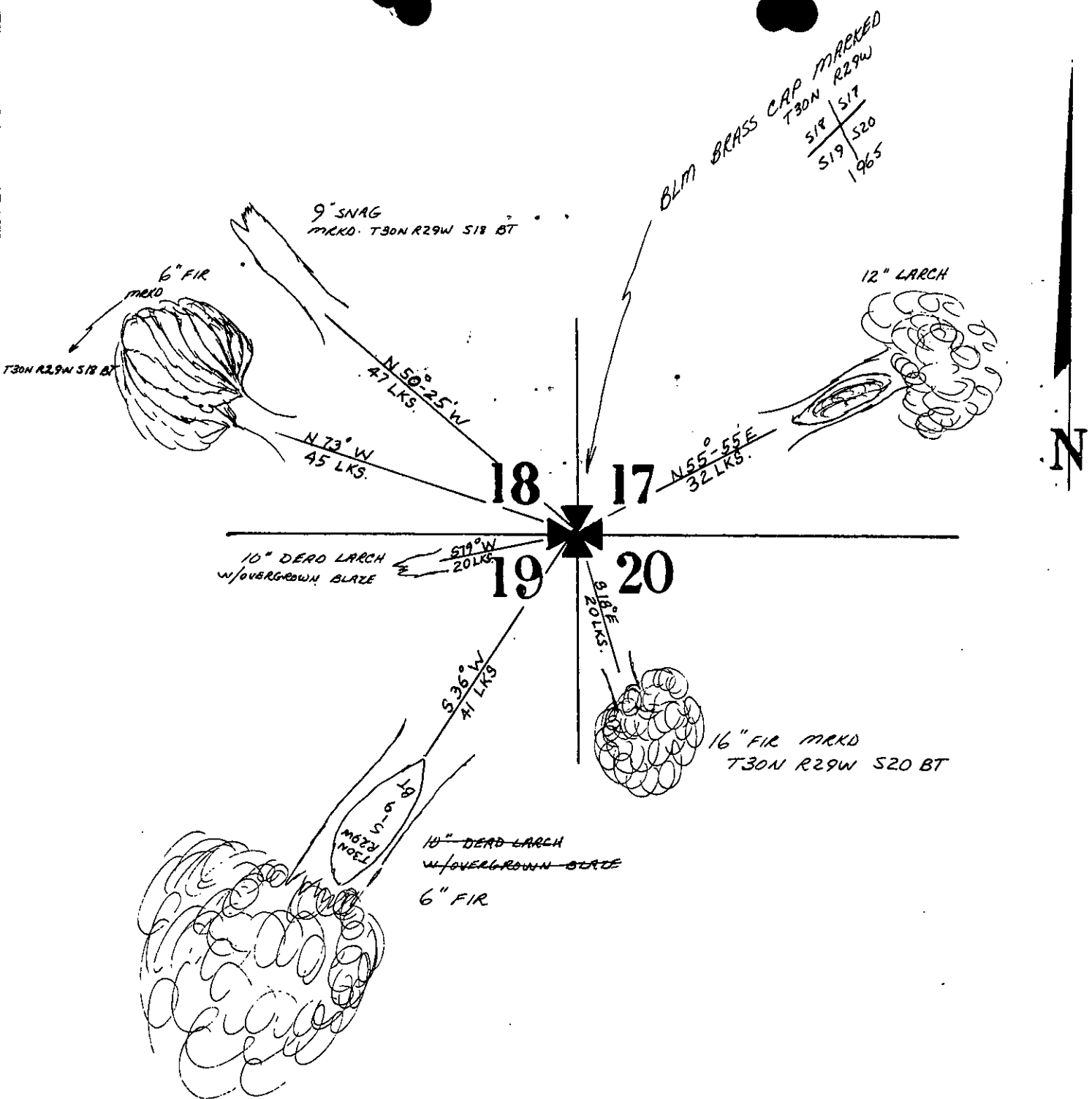
