Record: (1965 BLM) Set an iron post, 30" long, 2 1/2" diam, 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A stump, 26" diam, bears N 30°20'E, 36 lks dist mkd 1/4 S 21 BT

A rotted stump, bears S 21°E, 83 lks dist, mkd illegibly

A larch, 10" diam, bears S 8 1/2°E, 59 lks dist mkd 1/4 S 28 BT

A larch, 11" diam, bears N 17°W, 124 lks dist, mkd 1/4 S 21 BT

Bury original stone alongside of iron post.

Found: (1976) Iron pipe w/brass cap & bearing trees as described in record notes.

See certificate of survey # 213 for ties to adjacent corners.

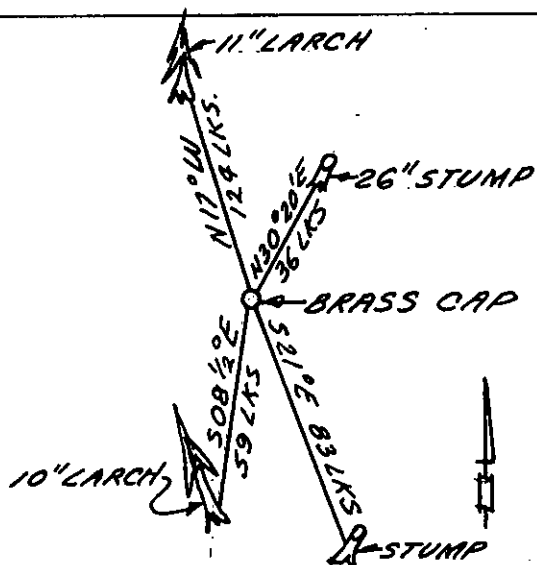
