

# CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

Corner Sections 20, 21, 28 & 29 T. 30 N., R. 29 W. MPM

Record (1965 BLM) Set an iron post, 30" long, 2 1/2" diam, 26" in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

S 29 S 28

From which:

A 20" diam stump, bears N 83 1/2°E, 66 lks dist, with fallen log mkd. T 30 N R 29 W S 21 BT

A stump hole, bears S 63°25'E 56 lks dist, with fallen log, no marks

A pine, 24" diam, bears S 43°20'W, 55 lks dist, with an overgrown blaze.

A pine, 20" diam, bears N 34 3/4°W, 17 lks dist, with an overgrown blaze.

A fir, 8" diam, bears N 36 3/4°E, 28 lks dist, mkd T30N R29W S21 BT

A pine, 9" diam, bears S 49°E, 54 lks dist, mkd T30N R29W S 28 BT

Bury the original stone alongside the iron post.

Found: (1976) an iron post with brass cap and bearing trees as described above.

See certificate of survey # 213 for ties to adjacent corners.

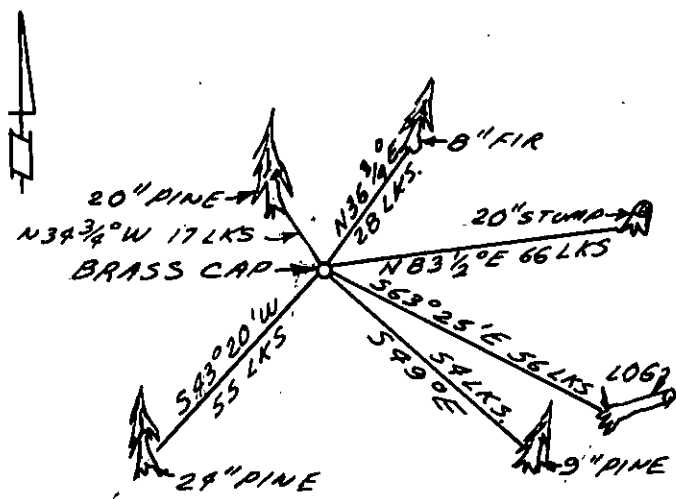
