$\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Sections 21 & 22 T. 30 N., R. 29 W., MPM

Record: (1964 BLM) Set an iron post, 30" long, 2 1/2" diam, 26" in the ground, with brass cap marked:

T. 30 N. R. 29 W.

S 21 | S 22
1964

From which:

A pine 14" diam, bears N 77 1/2° E, 28 lks dist.
A pine 14" diam, bears N 51° W, 25 lks dist.
Bury original stone alongside of iron post

Found: (1976) An iron post w/brass cap as described above and bearing trees as described. A mound of stone around pipe.

See certificate of survey # 213 for ties to adjacent corners.

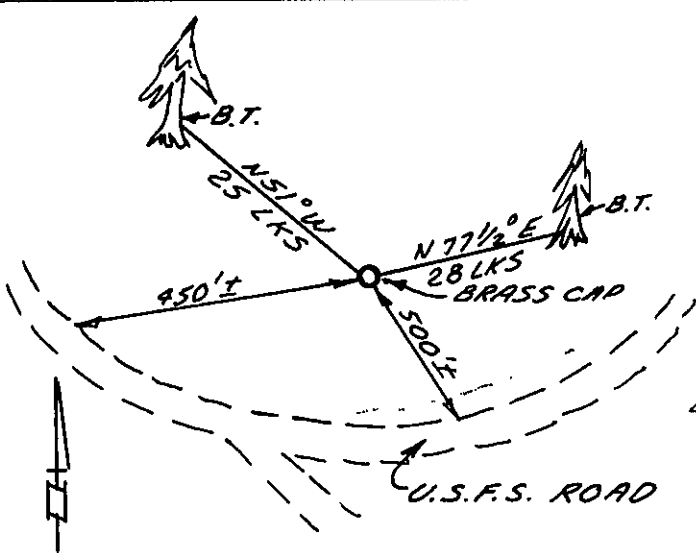
