1903 GLO record by G. A. Fessenden & R. Y. Lyman: Set a slate stone, 18x10x8 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., mkd. 1/4 on the N. face, from which:

A tamarack, 14 ins. diam., bears N 14 $^\circ$ 30'E, 50 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4 S 12 BT. A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S 16 $^\circ$ W, 20 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S13 BT.

II. Found a stone, 18x10x8 ins., firmly set in place, with 1/4 on the W. face, from which:

A larch, 18 ins. diam., bears N 14° E, 31.8 ft. (48 lks.) dist., mkd. with a healed face. (GLO Record: 50 1ks.)

A fir stump, 18 ins. diam., bears S 16 E, 13.2 ft. (20 lks.) dist., with a log laying alongside, mkd. with visible scribe marks. (GLO Record: S 16 W)

III. At the position of the found stone, I set a 2 1/2 in. diam., X 30 ins. long aluminum pipe, 24 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap mkd. as shown. Buried the original stone alongside the aluminum pipe.


Establised one new bearing tree:

A larch, 11 ins. diam., bears S 52° W, 20.0 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S13 BT.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker and Property Boundary decals, East, 3 ft.

Magnetic declination: 20° East
