
II. Found a 1" diam. rebar, from which:

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears  $N14^{\circ}$ E, 17.0 ft. dist. with a pitched over scribe.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S19 $^{\circ}$ E, 19.2 ft. dist. with a pitched over scribe.

III. As a result of Mr. Ninneman's acceptance of different corner positions for the SW and NW section corners of section 4, I find the Ninneman corner rebar bears  $S4^{\circ}W$ , 11.4 ft. dist. from my calculated corner position. Therefore, I do not accept the Ninneman rebar as the true W 1/16 south line. At my calculated position, I set a 3/4 in. diam. x 30 ins. long aluminum rod, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. U.S.D.A. aluminum cap, marked as shown.

Painted a red band around each bearing tree and attached Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs. Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker decal, 3 ft. East of the new monument.
