

1898 G.L.O. original record by Paul S.A. Bickel: Set a stone monument and two bearing trees.

1968 B.L.M. remonumentation record by Woodrow E. Damm et al: "The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 12 and 13, as determined from the remains of the original NW bearing tree. At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long,  $2\ 1/2$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

The original bearing tree:

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N24 $^{\circ}$ W, 44 1ks. dist., mkd. BT. (Record)

The new bearing tree:

A pine, 25 ins. diam., bears N54°W, 69 lks. dist., mkd. X BT."


II. Found, a 2 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, 2 ins. out of ground with 3 1/4 in. diam. B.L.M. brass cap marked as shown above, from which

A pine snag, 11 ins. diam., bears N22 W. 29.7 ft. (45 lks.) dist., BT scribe is visible. (G.L.O.) Root hole with log portion, bears N54 $^{\circ}$ W, 46.2 ft. (70 lks.) dist., all scribe is visible. (B.L.M.)

III. Established two new bearing trees:

A douglas fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N19 E, 52.1 ft. dist., scribed 1/4 S12 BT. A douglas fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N34 W, 57.2 ft. dist., scribed X BT.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Moñument and Bearing Tree signs. Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker and Property Boundary decals, west, 2 ft. Magnetic Declination:  $20^{\circ}30^{\circ}$  East
