

 - A larch snag, 24 ins. diam., bears $879^{\circ}E$, 28.3 ft. (42.9 lks.) dist., overgrown scribe blaze. A larch, 28 ins. diam., bears $862^{\circ}W$, 25.4 ft. (38.5 lks.) dist., overgrown scribe blaze.

 - A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N28 $^{\circ}$ W, 8.4 ft. (12.7 lks.) dist., pitched scribe blaze.
- III. Attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs on bearing trees. Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker and Property Boundary decals, North, 3 ft. Magnetic Declination: $21^{\circ}30^{\circ}$ East
