

1904 G.L.O. original record by G. W. Fessenden and R. Y. Lyman: Set a stone monument and marked two pine bearing trees.

1965 B.L.M. remonumentation record by D. G. Lindenberg: "The 1/4 sec. cor of secs. 26 and 35. monumented with a slate stone, 24x12x10 ins., loosely set, marked 1/4 on the N side and witnessed by the original bearing trees. At the corner point

The new bearing trees:

A larch, 11 ins. diam., bears N1 4 3/ 6 E, 42 lks. dist., mkd. 1/ 4 S26 BT. A larch, 11 ins. diam., bears S83 6 E, 26 lks. dist., mkd. 1/ 4 S35 BT.

Bury the original stone alongside the iron post."



 A larch, 13 ins. diam., bears S80 E, 17.8 ft. (27 lks.) dist., mkd. with overgrown scribe blaze.
