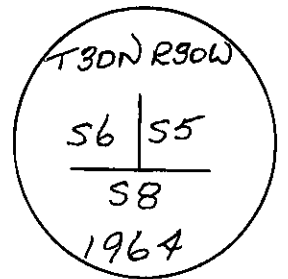


CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION  
(REFERENCE FSM 7153.53)

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found a BLM brass cap marked as shown.  
From which: A 6" dead douglas fir bears N10°E, 52 lks.(Sec.5 BT)  
A 28" ponderosa pine bears N47°W, 107 lks.(Sec 6 BT)  
  
1964 BLM Record: Set an iron post with brass cap from remains of original evidence.  
From which: A pine 20" diam. bears N47°W, 107 lks dist.  
A fir 6" diam. bears N10°E, 52 lks dist  
  
Bury original stone alongside of the iron post.



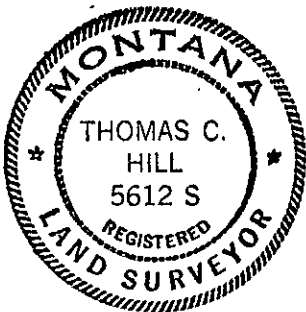
