Set a post, 4 feet long, 4 inches square, 24" in the ground for corner to Sections 8, 9, 16, and 17. Marked "T30N S9" on northeast, "R31W S16" on southeast, "S17" on southwest and "8" on northwest faces with 4 notches on south and east edges; from which:

A Fir, 16" diameter, bears N9½°E, 47 links (31.02 feet) distant, marked "T30N R31W S9 BT".

A Tamarack, 8" diameter, bears S81°35'E, 10 links (6.60 feet) distant, marked "T30N R31W S16 BT".

A Tamarack, 8" diameter, bears S341/2°W, 36 links (23.76 feet) distant, marked "T30N R31W S17 BT".

A Fir, 6" diameter, bears N1814°W, 35 links (23.10 feet) distant, marked "T30N R31W S8 BT".

BLM - 1962

The corner of Sections 8, 9, 16, and 17 monumented with an iron post, 2½ inches diameter, firmly set, protruding 6 inches above ground in a collar of stone with brass cap marked as shown below; from which:

The remains of the original bearing trees:

A decayed stump, bears N9½°E, 47 links (31.02 feet) distant, marked T30N R31W S9.

A Larch, 15" diameter, bears S761/4°E, 10 links (6.60 feet) distant, marked T30N R31W S16 BT on partially healed blaze (Record S81°35'E)

A Larch, 15" diameter, bears S34½°W, 36 links (23.76 feet) distant, marked T30N R31W S17 BT on partially healed blaze.

A Fir, 17" diameter, bears N25½°E, 26 links (17.16 feet) distant, marked T30N R31W S9 BT (Record N23°E).

A Fir, 24" diameter, bears N51°W, 60 links (39.6 feet) distant, marked T30N R31W S8 BT.

FOUND

Found 3/4" brass cap on 2 inch diameter iron pipe 0.4 feet above ground, marked as shown below.

A 15" Tamarack, bears S81½°E, 6.8 feet distant with healed blaze and bearing tag attached.

A 24" Fir, bears N51°W, 60 links (39.6 feet) distant with open blaze, visible scribing and bearing tag.

A 15" Tamarack, bears S37°W, 23.4 feet distant with healed blaze and "X" blaze.


