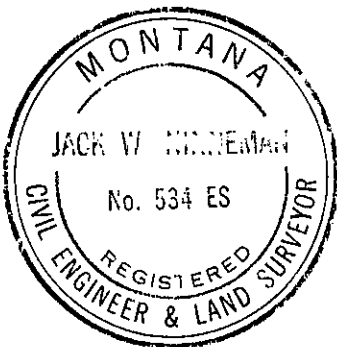
Date of work: Oct 1971

1. Brass cap by B.L.M.
2. Boat spike in center of road between brick gate posts.
3. Set a steel pin from which an 11" spruce bears N 75° E 6.2 Ft. An 8" fir bears S 80° 20' W 7.1 Ft. Both are scribed N 1/16 W and posted.
4. Steel pin by others.
5. Set a steel pin from which a 10" Cottonwood bears S 37° W 26.6 Ft. A 10" Cottonwood bears S 82° 40' W 26.5 Ft. Both trees are scribed 1/4 W and posted.
6. Set a steel pin from which a 10" Cottonwood bears N 63° 40' E 14 Ft, a 14" Cottonwood bears S 18° 50' E 11 Ft. Both are scribed 1/16 W and posted.
7. Pipe at road intersection by others.

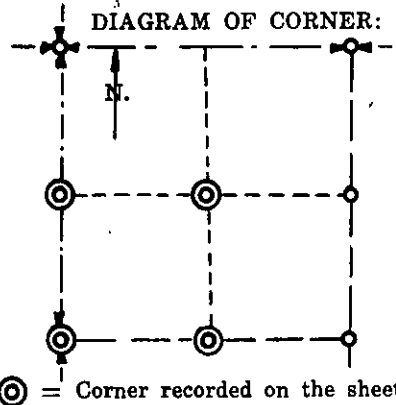
