"T30N S15" on the N.E., "R31W S.22" on the S.E., "S21" on the S.W. and "S16" on the N.W. faces, with 3 notches on the S. and E. edges. Set four bearing trees.

1962 B.L.M. Remonumentation Record by Gerald F. Pittman: The cor. of secs. 15,16,21&22, monumented by a wooden post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, set and mkd. as described in the official record and witnessed by the remains of the four original bearing trees.



A stump, 24 ins. diam., bears N04 1/2°E, 48 lks. dist., mkd. "T30N R31W S15 BT". (record)

A stump, 18 ins. diam., bears S59°E, 27 lks. dist., mkd. "T30N R31W S22 BT". (record)

A stump, 14 ins. diam., bears S36 1/4°W, 69 lks. dist., mkd. "T30N R31W S21 BT". (record) A stump, 20 ins. diam., bears N37 1/2°W, 18 lks. dist., mkd. "T30N R31W S16 BT". (record)




