Set a 3 1/4 inch aluminum cap stamped (see diagram below) on a 5/8 inch dia. rebar 20 inches long. From which


A 8.5 inch DBH Douglas Fir scribed S 17 1/4 BT. bears N 19° W 25.2 feet.
