

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

Reported Corner for Secs. 7,8,17, 18 -Twp. 30 N., R. 33 W.,M.P.M.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Post 4' long 4" square with a marked stone 12" in ground for Cor. to 7,8,17,18 4 notches on S and 5 on E. From which 16" Cottonwood N73 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 42.2 marked T 30N R33W S 8 BT 10" Spruce S74 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 74.6 marked T 30N R33W S 17 BT No other trees within limits dug pits in Secs. 7 & 18 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  distant and raised a mound of earth 2' high 4' base around corner post Found two trees agreeing substantially with record but could not confirm. Accordingly replaced this corner by double proportionate distances.

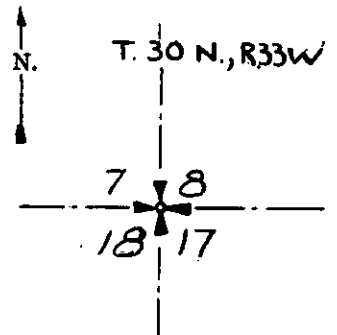
