

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Original and/or subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position.
2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated corners.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch or corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

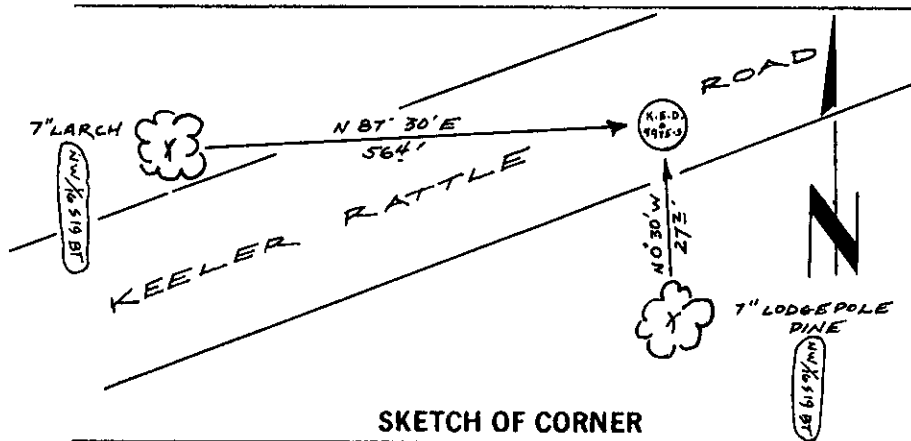
## CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner NW 1/16 th. Sec. 19 T. 30 N. R. 33 W. P.M.M. Lincoln County

Set 5/8" x 18" steel rebar with yellow P.V.C. cap stamped KED 4975 S for NW 1/16 corner. From which I scribed and marked two new bearing trees.

- 1) A larch 7 inches in dia. bears N 87° 30' E 56.4 feet in distance, scribed NW 1/16 S 19 Bt.
- 2) A lodgepole pine 7 inches in dia. bears N 0° 30' W, 27.2 feet in distance, scribed NW 1/16 S 19 Bt.

Painted the face scribe and red bands around each bearing tree and attached a bearing tree sign on each.

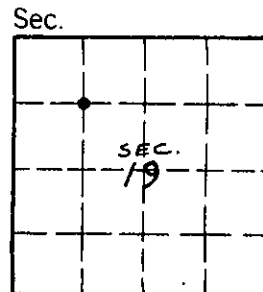
