1917 GLO Record: set a small stone, with a cross(X) under a quartzite stone 24x 9x6in., 14in. in the ground, mkd. CC 4 HES 577 on NW face and a cross(x) on top for exact corner point.

from which:

A cross(x) on a yellow pine, 22ins. diam., bears N.19°45'E., 109 lks.dist. A cross(x) on a yellow pine, 24ins. diam., bears east, 153 lks. dist. Each blazed and scribed 4 HES 577 BT. Raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base and 2 ft. high, NW of corner.

II. I found a 24x9x6in. stone, 10in. exposed with CC 4 HES 577 on NW face.

from which:

A pine snag, 21ins. diam., bears N.22°E., 72 ft. dist., scribing visable. A rotten stump, bears east 101 ft., no visable scribes.


III. I set a 2in. diam. by 30in. long aluminum pipe with a 34in. diam. aluminum cap surrounded by stone collar and mkd. as shown. Bury orig. stone alongside pipe.

from which the new BT's:

A larch, 13in. diam., bears S.71°E., 10.6 ft. dist., scribed 4 HES 577 BT. A fir, 15in. diam., bears N.16°E., 20.2 ft. dist., scribed 4 HES 577 BT.

Painted red bands around all BT's and attached new BT signs. Set a 6 ft. galvanized post 2 ft. in the ground 2 ft. NE of corner.
