

1966 Remonumentation by I.M. Tillotson. A certified corner recordation is on file in book 1 page 100 in the office of clerk and recorder, Lincoln Co., Mt. He shows he found remains of the original post and both original BT's and remonumented as follows:

To perpetuate this corner, in the exact position of the original burned out wood stake, we set a 28in. galvanized iron pipe, 12in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, packed with rock underground, with a brass cap mkd:




and create two new reference monument trees which bear from the corner as follows:

A 3in. larch bears S.86°E., 29 lks. dist., A 4in. larch bears N.56°W., 34 lks. dist., both double blazed and scribed "RM"

III. Found a 2½in. brass cap, firmly set, 2ins. above ground with a wooden post lying alongside.

- A larch snag, 18ins. diam., bears N.76°E., 17 ft., healed face.
- A larch snag, 14ins. diam., bears S.51°W., 14.5 ft., scribing visable.
- A larch, 5in. diam., bears S.87°E., 19.6 ft., healed face. A larch, 6in. diam., bears N.59°W., 22,5 ft., healed face.
