
I. <u>1893 G.L.O. original record by Daniel P. Mumbrue:</u> Set a quartzite stone, 24 x 10 x 4 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, mkd. "1/4" on W. face, from which,

A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N46 1/4°E, 43 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S. BT". A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S61°W, 14 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S. BT".

II. No evidence of original corner stone found. Found the remains of the original bearing trees:

A fir snag, 38 ins. diam., bears N46°E, 28.4 ft. (43 lks.) dist., with healed face. A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S61°W, 9.2 ft. (14 lks.) dist., with visible scribing.

III. At the position as determined by record distance-distance intersect from the found original bearing trees, set a 2 1/2 ins. diam., 30 ins. long alum. pipe, with a 3 1/4 ins. diam. alum. cap, 15 ins. above ground, with a large rock collar, mkd. as shown:




Established one new bearing tree:
