


CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

(REFERENCE FSH 5681.65)

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found underground remains of wood stake, about 2" square, from which center root hole of fallen 9" lodgepole pine (Record, 12" pine) bears the record S81°E, 20 links; and the center of root hole of fallen 8" lodgepole pine (Record, 10" Tam.) bears the record N60°W, 20 links. . Scribing on both trees clearly visible (1/4 S BT).

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:Date of work: October 26,
1967

Set 2" x 30" pipe 2 feet deep with brass cap in exact position of original stake, brass cap stamped as shown, from which: Larch, 32", bears S59°E, 52 links

Larch, 28", bears S70°W, 35-1/2 links

Measurements taken to the center of the tree; both trees blazed near base and scribed, 1/4 RP.
