From record dated 9/3/64:
Found original stone in place
Set 2 1/2" IP - 27" in ground T31N R30W
Brass Cap marked - S 20
Buried original stone S 29
alongside IP 1964

BT - S20 - 28"PP - N 25°E - 94 lks - Old BT
BT - S29 - 6"DF - S 86°W - 12 lks - New BT

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED
TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Date of work: May 24, 1972

The 6" DF BT was scorched by fire one year ago, apparently healthy now, scribing still visible, I reset the BLM metal tag.
The original P.Pine BT in S20 was cut and removed this spring. The stump is 24" dia. & 24" high and shows evidence of the old blaze. I set a 40d spike in center of stump, blazed stump facing corner and reset BLM metal tag.
There being no suitable green tree at a reasonable distance I made additional RM as follows: P.Pine stump, 24" dia, & 20" high, scribed "RM" facing corner, N 50° W, 41.5 lks to 40d spike in center of stump. St. Regis location poster fastened to stump facing corner.

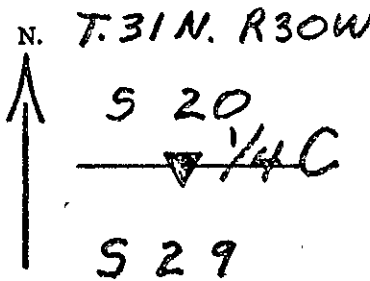
