

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Original and/or subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position.
2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated corners.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch of corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Land Surveyor registered in the State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

Original GLO Notes: Set a porphory stone 20x12x9 in., 15" in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face from which:

A fir 16" bears N70°45'E 59 lks., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S33 BT.
 A pine 30" bears S41°W 7 lks., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S32 BT.
 (1898 by Paul S.A. Bickel)

Corner monumentation survey: The corner of sec. 28, 29, 32, & 33, as determined from the remains of the original bearing trees.

At the corner point, set an iron post, 30" long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in diam., 27" in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T31N R30W

A larch 24" bears N28°E 95 lks., visible marks T31N R30W.
 (Record N59°10'E)
 A pine 18" bears S43°E 82 lks., blaze overgrown.
 A decayed stump bears S7°W 97 lks., no marks visible.
 A larch 18" bears N78°W 26 lks., visible marks R30W S29.

The new bearing tree:

A fir 9" bears S13°W 28 lks., Mkd. T31N R30W S32 BT.
 (1964 by Gerald F. Pittman, Cadastral Surveyor)

Found a BLM 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap on 2" iron pipe mon. w/ stones piled around mon.

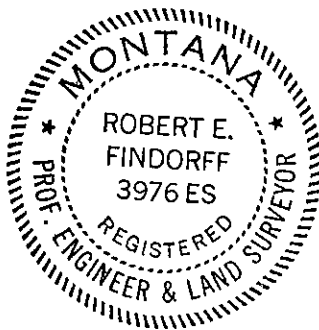

SKETCH OF CORNER (SEE ABOVE)

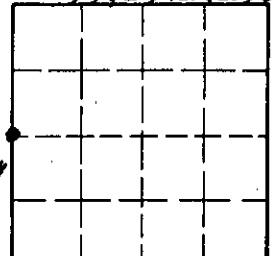
