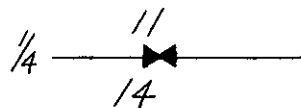

N. T31N R30W

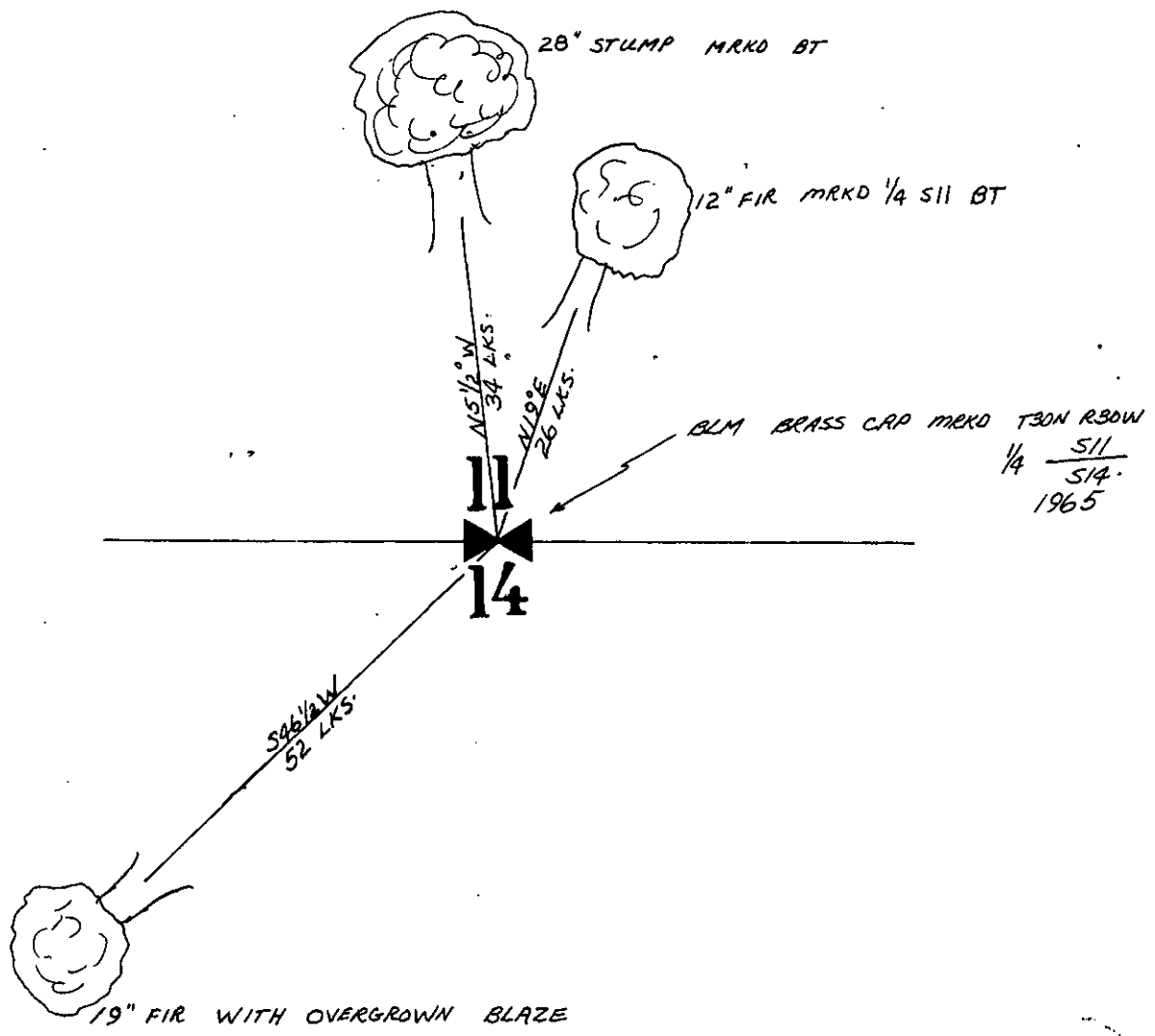
