Found: Bearing tree still in tact however the bearing varied to S49 1/8° W

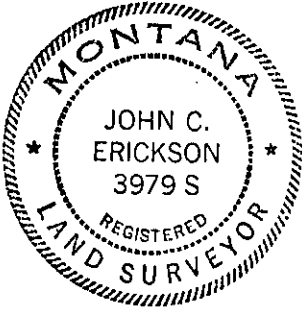

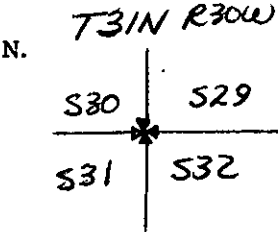

DIAGRAM OF CORNER:

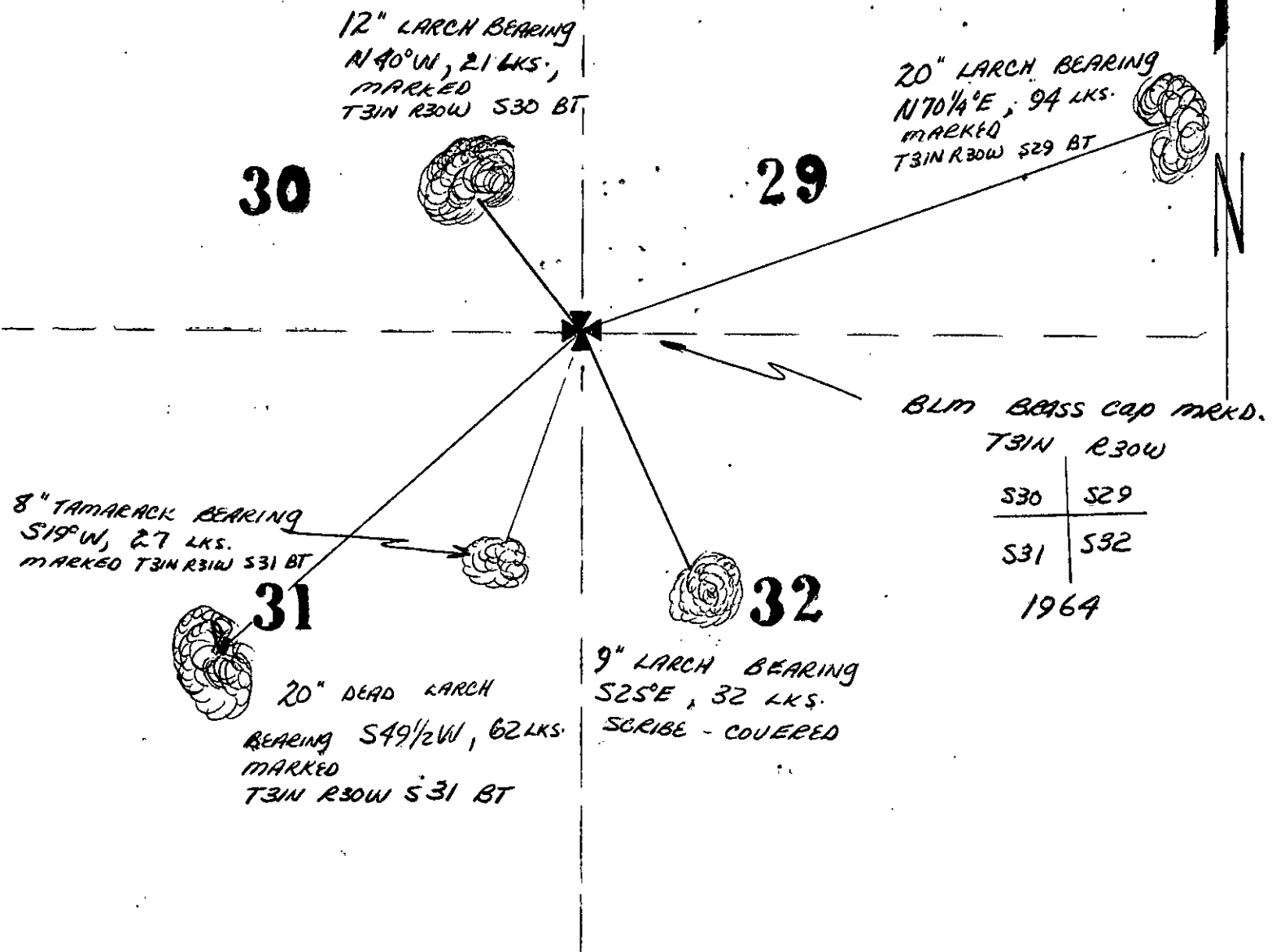

Description of evidence and original record continued

- Record: 8" larch bearing S25°E, 32 lks., marked T31N R30W S32 BT
 Found: Bearing tree ~~still~~ alive and still growing and presently 9" in diameter and the blaze was completely overgrown
- Record: 8" larch bearing S19°W, 27 lks., marked T31N R30W S31 BT
 Found: Bearing tree alive and still 8" in diameter with scribe covered
- Record: 9" larch bearing N40°W, 21 lks., and marked T31N R30W S30 BT
 Found: Bearing tree alive and still growing and presently 12" in diameter
