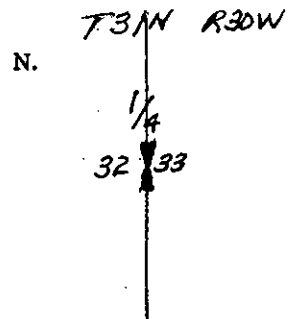

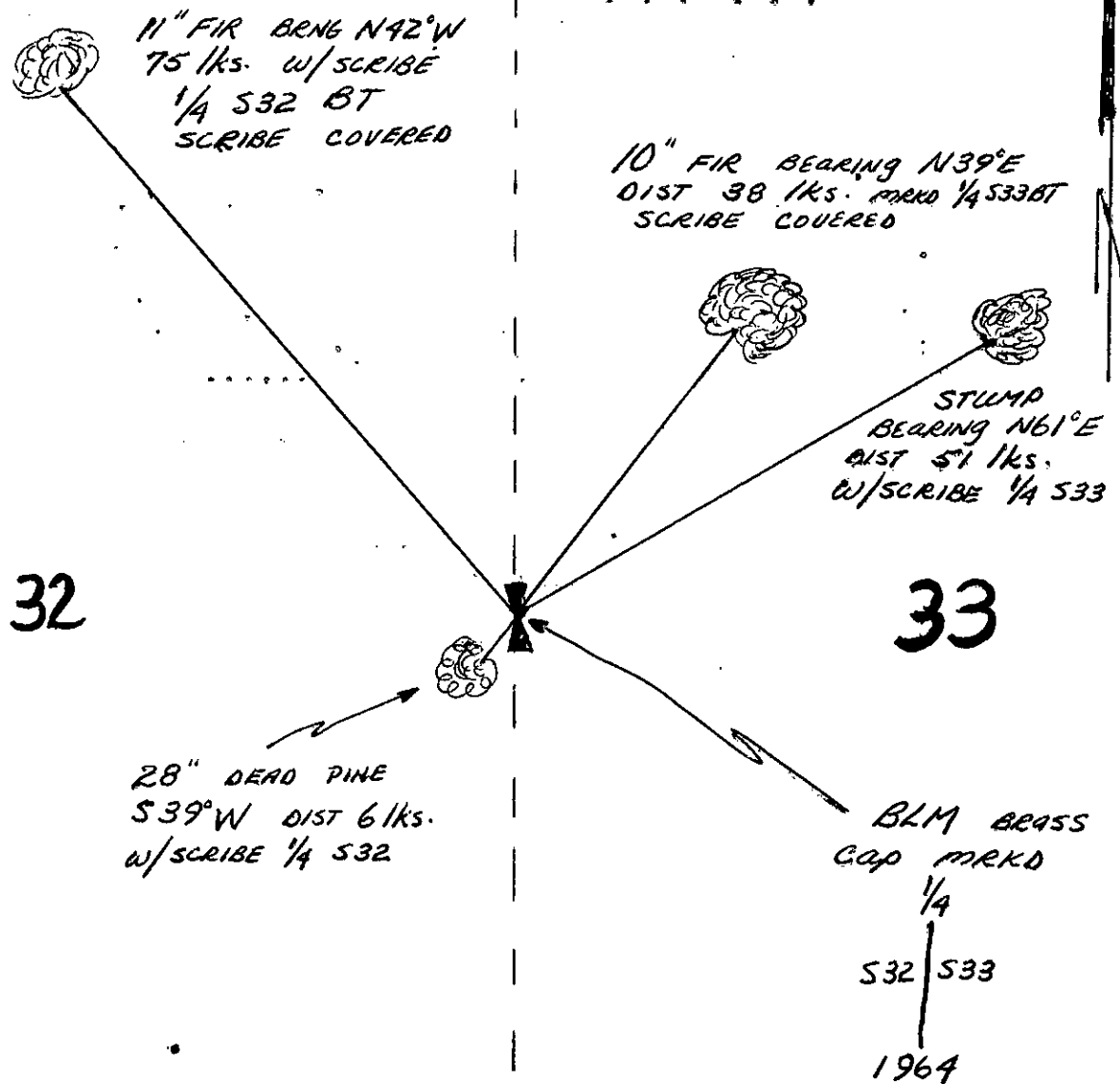
DIAGRAM OF CORNER:
