

CC of Secs. 19 and 30 P.M.M. Corner County

1898 G.L.O. record by Paul S. Bickel: Set a stone monument and two bearing trees.

"The closing cor. of secs. 19 and 30, 1962 B.L.M. remonumentation record by Gerald F. Pittman et al: monumented with limestone, 14x10x6 ins., firmly set and mkd. as described in the official record, and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees. At corner point; set an iron post, 37 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



from which:

The remains of the original bearing trees:

A pine, 17 ins. diam., bears N49 E, 45 lks. dist., mkd. CC T31N R30W S19 BT.

(Record: N29 38'E, 47 1ks.)

A stumphole, bears S57 E, 17 1ks. dist., remains of tree lying on ground, mkd. CC T31N R30W S30 BT. (Record: S9 12'E, 17 1ks.)

The new bearing tree:

A pine, 13 ins. diam., bears 842° E, 39 lks. dist., mkd. CC T31N R30W S30 BT.

Bury the original stone alongside and raise a flat mound of stone, 4 ft. diam., around the iron post.

Found a 2 1/2 ins. diam. iron pipe, 4 ins. out of ground with a 3 1/4 ins. diam. B.L.M. brass cap, marked as shown above; from which:

A pine snag, 17 ins. diam., bears $N52^{\circ}E$, 30.0 ft. (45 lks.) dist., healed face. (Record: $N29^{\circ}38^{\circ}E$, 47 lks.)

A pine, 14 ins. diam., bears $$542^{\circ}E$, 25.1 ft. (38 lks.) dist., mkd. 31N R30W S30 BT.


III. Establish one new bearing tree:

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N77 $^{\circ}$ E, 16.7 ft. dist., mkd. T31N R30W S19 CC BT.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker and Property Boundary decals, North, 3 ft.

Magnetic Declination: 20 East
