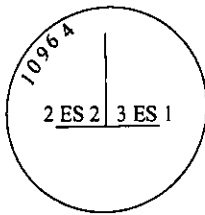


CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner MS 10964 COR. 3 Sec. 26 T. 31N R. 30W P.M., MT. Lincoln County
EASTSIDE NO. 1

- I. 1976 Original B. L. M. survey by Arthur C. Rader: Cor. No. 3, identical to Cor. No. 2 of the Eastside No. 2 Lode of this survey. Set an iron post, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. long, 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. 3-ES1 2-ES2-10964; from which:
- A larch, 12 ins. diam., bears NORTH, 16.4 ft. dist. mkd. 3-ES1-10964 BT.
A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears N 7°00' W, 0.2 ft. dist., mkd. 2-ES2-10964 BT.
- II. Found a 1 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, 10 ins. above ground, firmly set, with a 3 in. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown:



from which:

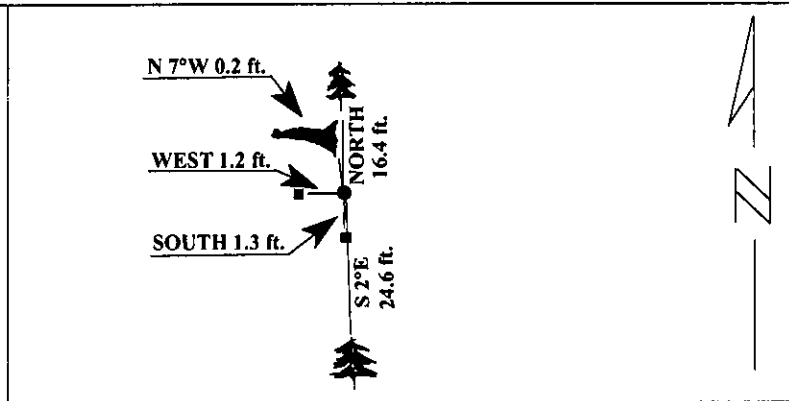
- A larch, 14 ins. diam., bears NORTH, 16.4 ft. dist., mkd. with visible scribe marks.
A dead and down pine, 10 ins. diam., bears N 7°W, 0.2 ft. dist., mkd. with visible scribe marks.
A steel guard post with Property Boundary decal attached, bears SOUTH, 1.2 ft. dist.
A steel guard post with Property Boundary decal attached, bears WEST, 1.3 ft. dist.

- III. Establish one new bearing tree:

A larch, 10 ins. diam., bears S 2°E, 24.6 ft. dist., mkd. X BT.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.

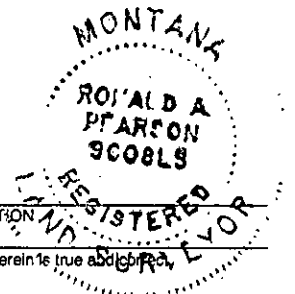

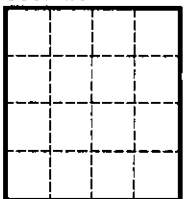
