
I. 1976 Original B. L. M. survey by Arthur C. Rader: Cor. No. 2, identical with Cor. no. 3 of the CPD No. 6 lode of this survey. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. 2CPD5-3CPD6-10965; from which:

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N 78° W, 8.3 ft. dist. mkd. 2CPD5-10965 BT.

A larch, 20 ins. diam., bears S 13°40' W, 28.0 ft. dist., mkd. 2CPD5-10965 BT.

A cor. of the location bears S 45° 15'E, 1.0 ft. dist.

II. Found a 1 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, 19 ins. above ground, firmly set, with a 3 in. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown:



from which:

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N 85°W, 8.3 ft. dist. (Rec: N 78° W)

A larch snag, 8 ins. diam., bears S 27°W, 28.0 ft. dist., mkd. with visible scribe marks. (Rec: S 13° 40'W)


A steel guard post with a property boundary decal attached. 0.6 ft. dist.

III. Established one new bearing tree:


A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N 20°E, 36.4 ft. dist., mkd. "X" BT.
