

I. 1972 Original B. L. M. survey by Arthur C. Rader: Cor. No. 2, identical with Cor. no. 3 of the CPD No. 2 lode of this survey. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. 2CPD1-3CPD2-10965; from which:

> A larch, 10 ins. diam., bears N 34° 40' E, 3.2 ft. dist. mkd. 3CPD2-10965 BT. A larch, 14 ins. diam., bears S 82° W, 22.8 ft. dist., mkd. 2CPD1-10965 BT. A cor. of the location bears N 87° 54'E, 106.7 ft. dist.

H. Found a 1 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, 18 ins. above ground, firmly set, with a 3 in. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown:.




from which:

A larch, 16 ins. diam., bears N 86°W, 22.2 ft. dist. (Rec: S 82° W)
A larch, 10 ins. diam., bears N 62°E, 3.2 ft. dist., mkd. with visible scribe marks. (Rec:N 34° 40' E)


A steel guard post bears NE, 0.4 ft. dist., with a property boundary decal attached.

III. Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
