
## **CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION**

MS 10935 COR. 4 Sec. 10 T. 31N R. 30W P.M., MT. Corner Lincoln County **RAINY NO. 12** 

I. 1972 Original B. L. M. survey by Arthur C. Rader: Cor. No. 4. Set an iron post, 1 1/2 ins. diam., 30 ins. long, 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. 4-R12-10935; from which:

> A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S 4°W, 26.0 ft. dist., mkd. 4-R12 10935 BT. A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S 37°W, 13.0 ft. dist., mkd. 4-R 12-10935 BT.

II. Found a 1 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown:



from which:

A dead pine, 13 ins. diam., bears S 4°W, 20.0 ft. dist., mkd. with visible scribe marks. (Rec:26.0 ft.)

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S 37°W, 13.0 ft. dist., mkd. with visible scribe marks.

A 6 ft. steel guard post bears S 8°W, 1.8 ft. dist., with a Property Boundary decal attached.

A 6 ft. steel guard post bears S 58°W, 4.0 ft. dist., with a Property Boundary decal attached. A 4 in. by 4 in. square wooden post bears S 18°W, 7.5 ft. dist.


III. Establish one new bearing tree:

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S 35°E, 8.3 ft. dist., mkd. 4 R 12 10935 BT.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East
