

I. 1972 Original B. L. M. survey by Arthur C. Rader: Cor. No. 2, identical to Cor. No. 3, Rainy No. 10 lode of this survey. Set an iron post, 1 1/2 ins. diam., 30 ins. long, 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. 2-LC2 3-R10-10935; from which:

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N 22°W, 11.0 ft. dist., mkd. 2-LC2-10935 BT. A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S 39°W, 25.0 ft. dist., mkd. 3-R10 10935 BT.

II. Found a 1 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown:.




from which:

A fir, 19 ins. diam., bears N 44°E, 11.0 ft. dist., mkd. with visible scribe marks. (Rec: N 22°W) A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S 25°W, 25.0 ft. dist., mkd. with visible scribe marks. (Rec: S 39°W) A 6 ft. steel guard post bears NE, 3.6 ft. dist., with a Property Boundary decal attached.

III. Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
