

1972 Original B. L. M. survey by Arthur C. Rader: Cor. No. 3, identical to Cor. No. 2, Last Chance No. 6 lode of this survey. I. Set an iron post, 1 1/2 ins. diam., 30 ins. long, 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. 3-LC2 2-LC6-10935; from which:

> A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S 25°W, 10.0 ft. dist., mkd. 3-LC2-10935 BT. A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N 65°E, 16.0 ft. dist., mkd. 2-LC6-10935 BT.

II. Found a 1 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown:.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S 25°W, 9.0 ft. dist., mkd. 3 LC2 10935 BT.


A fir, 21 ins. diam., bears N 68°E, 16.3 ft. dist., mkd. 2 LC


