

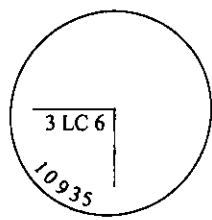
# CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner **MS 10935 COR. 3** Sec. **10** T. **31N** R. **30W** P.M., MT. **Lincoln** County  
**LAST CHANCE**  
**NO. 6**

I. 1972 Original B. L. M. survey by Arthur C. Rader: Cor. No. 3. Set an iron post, 1 1/2 ins. diam., 30 ins. long, 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. 3-LC6-10935; from which:

- A pine, 6 ins. diam., bears N 70°W, 9.0 ft. dist., mkd. 3-LC6-10935 BT.
- A pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S 50°W, 16.0 ft. dist., mkd. 3-LC6 10935 BT.

II. Found a 1 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, 8 ins. above ground, firmly set in a collar of stone, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown:



from which:

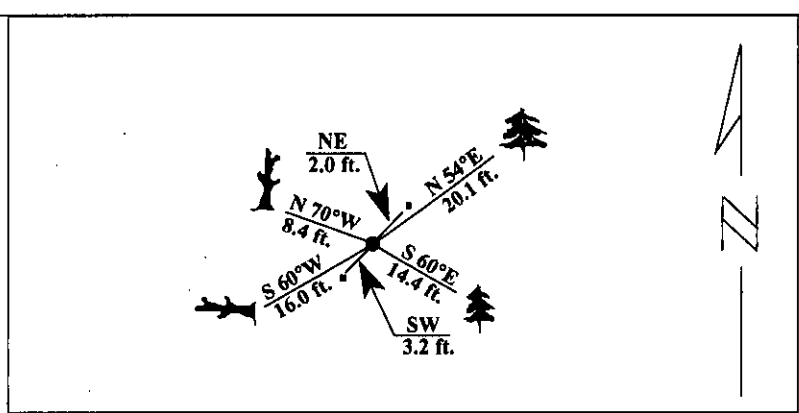
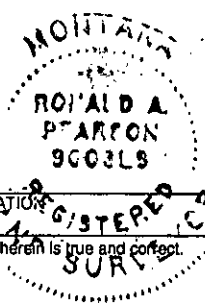
- A pine snag, 8 ins. diam., bears N 70°W, 8.4 ft. dist., mkd. 3 LC6 10935 BT.
- A down pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S 60°W, 16.0 ft. dist., mkd. 3 LC 6 10935 BT.
- A 6 ft. steel guard post bears SW, 3.2 ft. dist., with a Property Boundary decal attached.
- A 6 ft. steel guard post bears NE, 2.0 ft. dist., with a Property Boundary decal attached.

III. Establish two new bearing trees:

- A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S 60°E, 14.4 ft. dist., mkd. X BT.
- A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N 54°E, 20.1 ft. dist., mkd. 3 LC6 10935 BT.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East
