
## **CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION**

MS 10935 COR. 4 R. 30W P.M., MT. Corner Sec. 10 31N Lincoln County RAINY NO. 6

1972 Original B. L. M. survey by Arthur C. Rader: Cor. No. 4, identical with Cor. No. 1 Rainy No. 14 lode. Set an iron post, Ĭ. 1 1/2 ins. diam., 30 ins. long, 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. 4-R6 1-R14-10935, from which:.

> A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N 40°E, 15.0 ft. dist., mkd. 1 R 14 10935 BT. A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears S 45°E, 22.0 ft. dist., mkd. 4 R6 10935 BT.

II. Found a 1 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, 5 ins. above ground, firmly set, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown:



from which:

A snag, 8 ins. diam., bears N 40°E, 15.0 ft. dist., mkd. 1 R 14 10935 BT.

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S 45°E, 22.0 ft. dist., mkd. 4 R6 10935 BT.

A 6 ft. steel guard post bears S 34°E, 1.7 ft. dist., with a Property Boundary decal attached.


A 6 ft. steel guard post bears N 4°W, 1.8 ft. dist., with a Property Boundary decal attached.

III. Establish two new bearing trees:

> A larch, 9 ins. diam., bears N 28°E, 24.3 ft. dist., mkd. X BT. A larch, 13 ins. diam., bears S 80°E, 24.5 ft. dist., mkd. 4 R6 10935 BT.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
