
## **CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION**

I. <u>1976 Certified Corner Recordation by Melvin Lauteren, 4232S:</u> Set by survey, a 1 in. diam. iron pipe, with brass cap mkd. as shown, per Certificate of Survey no. 215, by 4232S.



- II. Found a 1 1/4 in. diam. iron pipe, with a 3 in. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown above, and not accepted, corner was projected per Certificat of survey no. 215, by 4232S.
- III. Set by survey, a driveable aluminum rod, 30 ins. long, 3/4 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap, mkd. as shown. A collar of stone, surrounds the monument.




Established two bearing trees:

A larch, 12 ins. diam., bears S89°E, 20.2 ft. dist., mkd. "CNS1/64 S27 BT". A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S27°W, 11.9 ft. dist., mkd. "CNS1/64 S27 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs. The found iron pipe, bears N45°E, 2.5 ft. dist. from the newly established monument.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
