
## **CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION**

Corner W 1/4 Sec. 14 T. 31 N R. 30 W P.M., MT. Lincoln County

I. 1939 Original G.L.O. survey by Ranny Y. Lyman: Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., with brass cap marked:



from which:

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N 65°0'E, 18 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4 S 14 BT. A pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S 60°0'W, 23 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 15 BT.

II. Found an iron pipe., 2 1/2 ins. diam., 10 ins. above ground, firmly set, with a 2 1/2 in. daim. brass cap mkd. as shown above, from which:

A pine high stump, 11 ins. diam., bears N 65°E, 11.9 ft. (18 lks.) dist., mkd 1/4 S 14 BT. A pine high stump, 11 ins. diam., bears S 60°W, 15.2 ft. (23 lks.) dist., mkd with visible scribe marks.

III. Establish two new bearing trees:


A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S 64°E, 23.0 ft. dist., mkd 1/4 S 14 BT. A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S 64°W, 53.6 ft. dist., mkd 1/4 S 15 BT.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
