Set a sandstone 16x14x5 inches, 11" in the ground, for 1/2 Section Corner marked 1/2 on West face; from which:

A Yellow Pine, 28" diameter, bears N10°E, 84 links (55.44') distant, marked 1/4 S 18 BT.

A Yellow Pine, 24" diameter, bears N71°30'W, 89 links (58.74') distant, marked 1/4 S13 BT.

FOUND:

Original stone 16x10x5 inches in place with 1/4 on West face.

A 36" pine on ground with visible scribing bears N08°E, 122.18 feet distant.

A 39" pine with visible scribing bears N72°W, 57.09 feet distant.


ESTABLISH:

Replace original found stone with 3½" standard aluminum monument marked as shown below. Buried original stone along side monument and place rock cairn around monument.

An 11" Douglas Fir bears S7°E, 10.99 feet distant, blaze and scribe 1/2 S18 BT.

Paint bearing trees with red paint and attach bearing tree tags.
