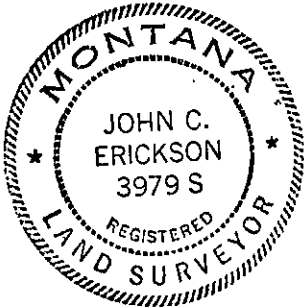

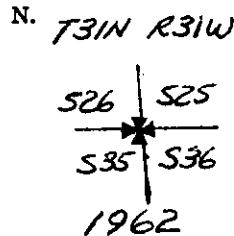

DIAGRAM OF CORNER:



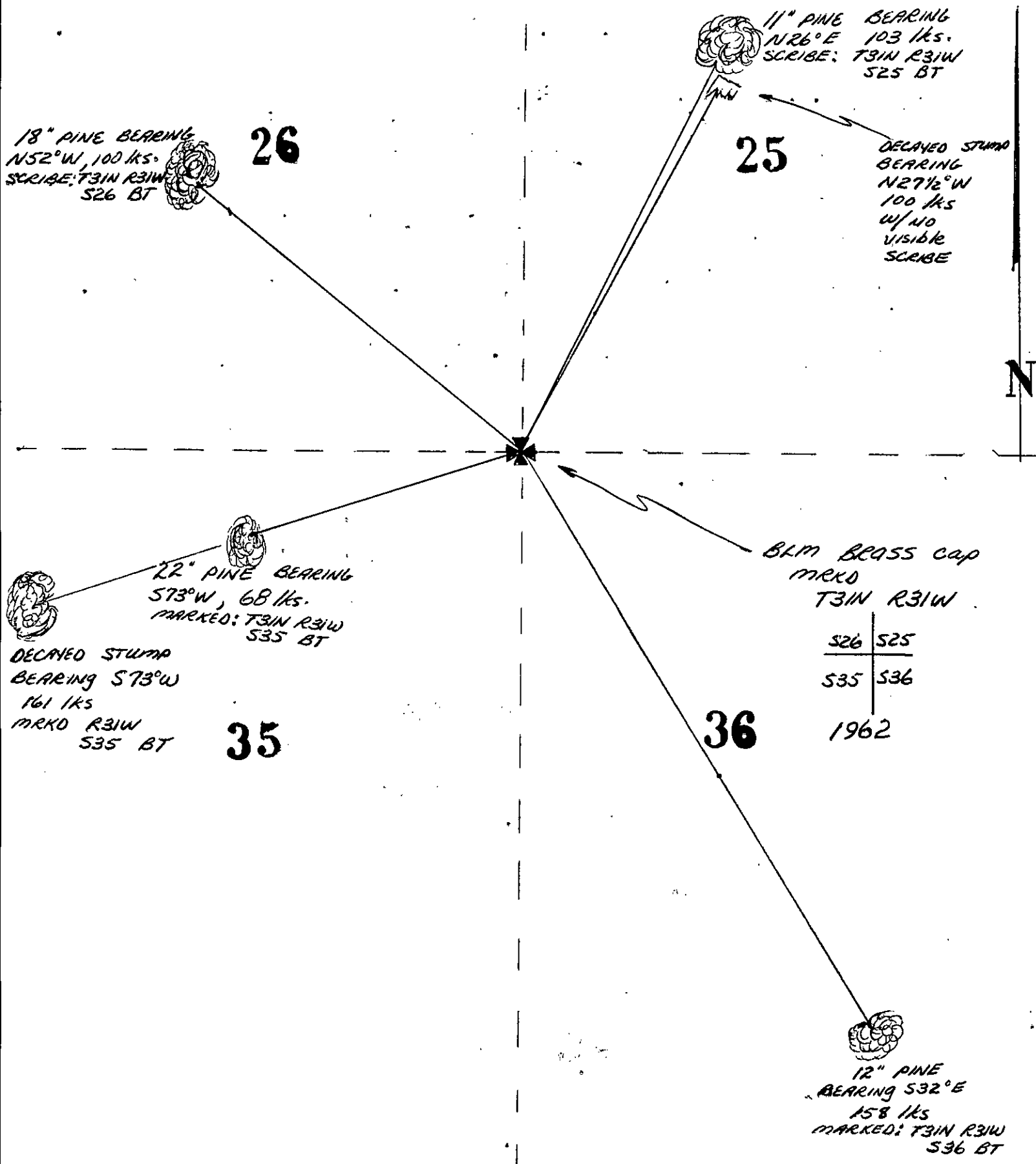
