
1893 G.L.O. original record by Daniel P. Mumbrue: Set a stone and four bearing trees Sec. Cor. common to Secs. 18 and 19 T31N R30W, and Secs. 13 and 24 T31N R31W.

1901 G.L.O. retracement record by Abram L. Jaqueth: Establishes cor. for Secs. 18 & 19 only.

1903 G.L.O. township subdivision record by George A. Pessenden and Ranney Y. Lyman: Destroy Jaqueth cor. and establishes closing corner for Secs. 18 & 19 only.

1963 BLM remonumentation by Gerald F. Pittman et al: "The cor. of sec.13 and 24, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., as determined from the original bearing trees.

At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground.


A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N38 $1/4^{\circ}$ W, 14 lks. dist., mkd. with an overgrown blaze. (Record) A larch. 26 ins. diam., bears S20 $1/2^{\circ}$ W, 102 lks. dist., mkd. with an overgrown blaze. (record)

- II. Found a 2 1/2 ins. diam. pipe, 2 ins. out of the ground, with BLM brass cap mkd. as shown, from which A dead larch, 26 ins. diam., bears \$20 w, 67.2 ft. (102 lks.) dist., no visible scribing. A douglas fir. 22 ins. diam., bears N36°W. 9.4 ft. (14 lks.) dist., visible scribing.
- III. Establish one new bearing tree:

A douglas fir, 10 ins. diam., bears ${\rm S26}^{\rm O}$ W, 47.5 ft. dist., mkd. T31N R31W S24 BT.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs. Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker and Property Boundary decals South, 3 ft.
