

A pine, 18 ins. diam., bears S42°E, 10.15 ft. dist., mkd. with visible scribe A pine, 16 ins. diam., bears S77°W, 15.58 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face.

Found a steel guard post, North, 1 ft. of corner, 14 ins. above the ground.

III. At the position determined by survey, accepted the found monument and set a 30 in. long, 2 1/2 in. diam. aluminum pipe, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap, firmly set, 2 ins. above the ground, mkd. as shown:




Put the T-stake inside the pipe, removed the found steel guard post.
