CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION


Corner 1/4 Sec. 28/33 T. 31N R. 31W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1893 original G.L.O. record by Daniel P. Munbubrue: Set post and marked two bearing trees.

1962 B.L.M. Remonumentation record by G. F. Pittman, R. L. Larimer and H. W. Grusing: The 1/4 cor. of secs. 28 and 33, monumented with the decayed remains of a wooden post, firmly set in the ground, and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees.

At the corner point:

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd:



from which:

The remains of the original bearing trees:

A stumphole, bears S56 1/2°W, 32 lks. dist.

A stump, 20 ins. diam., bears N7°W, 50 lks. dist., mkd. with an overgrown blaze.

Established 2 new bearing trees:

A pine, 15 ins. diam., bears S36°E, 54 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S 33 BT". A pine, 19 ins. diam., bears N35°W, 73 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S28 BT".

Buried the remains of the original wooden post alongside, and raised a flat mound of stone, 3 ft. diam., around the iron post.

II. Found a B.L.M. brass cap, firmly set, 28 ins. in the ground, marked as shown above:


from which:

A pine, ins. diam., bears S36°E, 36.2 ft. (55 lks.) dist., with visible scribing. (B.L.M. rec. 54 lks.)

A pine, 22 ins. diam., bears N35°W, 48.1 ft. (73 lks.) dist., with visible scribing. (B.L.M.) A rotten stump, bears N7°W, 33.0 ft. (50 lks.) dist. (G.L.O.)

III. Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
