- I. 1980 Corner Recordation by J. H. Ninneman # 4661-S: "Set a 5/8 in. x 24 in. steel rod with yellow cap stamped J.H.N. 4661 S & two B.T.s."
- II. A 5/8 in. diam. rebar, 1 in. above ground, firmly set, with a broken plastic yellow cap mkd. as shown.



from which:

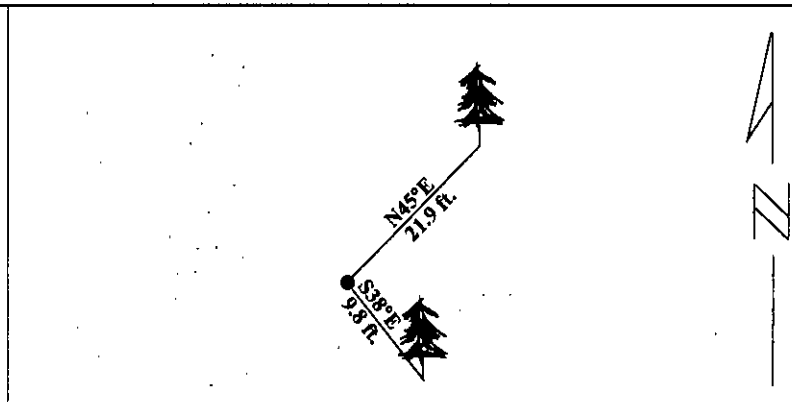
A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears S38°E, 9.8 ft. dist., "S 1/16 S9 BT" visible.
No other bearing tree found.

- III. With no trees available in sec. 8, I establish one new bearing tree in sec. 9:

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N45°E, 21.9 ft. dist., mkd. "S 1/16 S9 BT".

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East



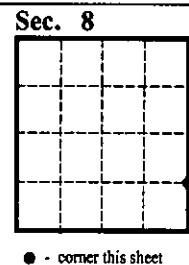
